

Setting up VPN

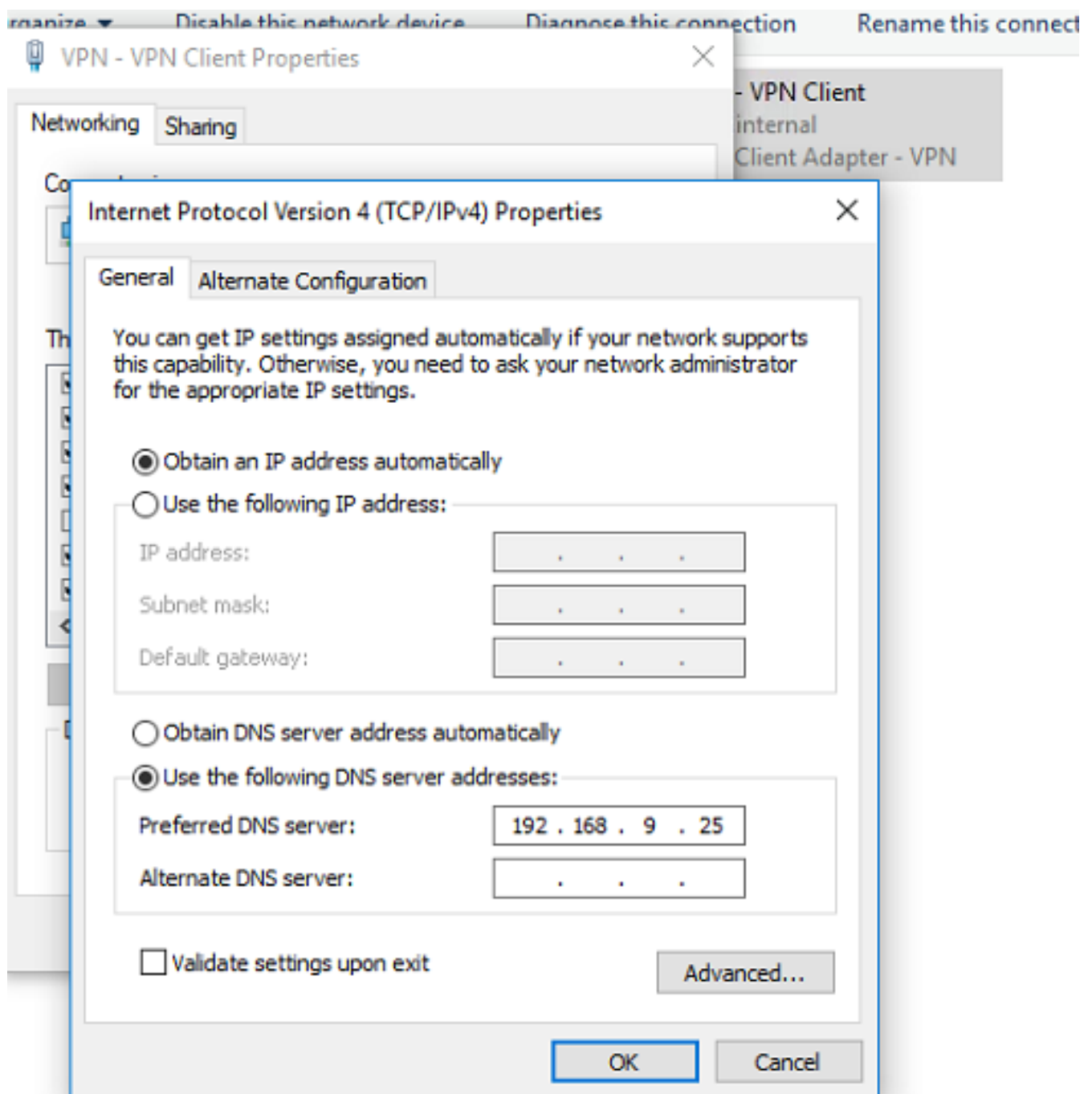
1. Download and install QuikBox VPV client
2. start VPN and set as start up
