
## Win 11 password reset using Command Prompt

> Start the system and go to Logon screen.


Go to troubleshoot.

> Go to right downside and select power icon and go to restart, press and hold the shift key and go with restart (do not release shift key until see the troubleshooting option looks like below image)





> Go to Command Prompt



- Once open the command prompt it's look like this above image.
- Now just we need to go into C drive using below command.
  - a. c: (press enter)
  - b. dir (press enter)
  - c. cd Windows (press enter)
  - d. cd system32 (press enter)



- Now we need to rename files for further process and now we are at c:\windows\system32. (need to enter below commands)
  - a. ren utilman.exe utilman1.exe (press enter)
  - b. ren cmd.exe utilman.exe (press enter)

C:\Windows\System32>ren utilman.exe utilman1.exe
C:\Windows\System32>ren cmd.exe utilman.exe\_

Nowjust enter
a. exit

Go with continue.



- > Once we click on continue it's restarted the window and again, we are on Logon screen.
- > Go to right downside and click on Accessibility.
- > Once we click on Accessibility there are open a command prompt if it does not open need to one more time restart system and again Click on Accessibility.
- > Now command prompt is open need to type some commands.
  - a. **net user** (press enter This command shows the users on this system, and we need to find our user that can we reset the password in my case I have a username of admin)
  - b. net user admin \* (press enter)
  - c. admin@12345 (enter your new password)
  - d. admin@12345 (Re Enter the password)
- restart the system and try to login with new password.
